2026 ATLS Global Symposium | March 13-15, 2026

Deadline for Submission: October 15, 2025

Theme: *Global Unity, Local Impact: Advancing ATLS & Trauma Education Everywhere*

Be part of a global conversation about how trauma education—especially the ATLS® (Advanced Trauma Life Support) program—is saving lives and strengthening trauma systems in every corner of the world. This showcase invites educators, clinicians, administrators, and change-makers to share how trauma education is adapted, scaled, and sustained across diverse settings, whether through rigorous investigation (**Scientific Category**) or pragmatic, high-impact solutions (**Best Practices Category**).

Poster Topics May Include:

Scientific Category Examples

- Clinical outcomes for ATLS driven protocols
- Data-driven outcomes from ATLS or related educational interventions
- Comparative studies of airway devices in resource-limited settings
- Epidemiologic analyses of injury patterns & prevention

Best Practices Category Examples

- Localization of trauma curricula to meet cultural or resource-specific needs
- Stories of collaboration between global partners and local communities
- Policy change or systems integration driven by trauma education
- Low-cost simulation models for courses

Why Present?

- Showcase your program's global relevance and local achievements
- Demonstrate how ATLS continues to evolve and empower care teams worldwide
- Gain recognition among international peers and trauma leaders
- Spark dialogue and collaboration across borders and disciplines

Submission Requirements:

- Select category (Scientific or Best Practices)
- Poster title and authors
- Abstract for Scientific category (max 250 words)
- Overview of Program or Intervention for Best Practices (max 250 words)
- Keywords
- Presenter Name(s), Roles, and Credentials
- Conflict-of-interest disclosure
- Results, Measurable Outcomes, or Lessons Learned
- Optional: Visual mock-up, diagram, or illustrative graphic
- Language: English (with optional second-language PDF for onsite distribution)

Presenter Requirements:

- At least one author must register for the full symposium by January 31, 2026.
- Presenters are responsible for poster printing, mounting, and removal.
- Authors grant the organizers a non-exclusive license to share e-posters on ACS website and/or social media.
